When: June 26th-June 29th (Date is confirmed)

Where: New York City (Location is confirmed)

Travel accommodations: You can certainly book your own travel; however, if you require travel accommodations, you may reach out to Loletta Hayes, travel agent, (912) 346-6890 for assistance.

Arrival Time: TBD (I recommend morning arrival to make the most of the day).

Departure Time: Most hotels will agree to store you luggage until your departure. I would recommend a later departure to make the most of your time in NY. We could opt to do some shopping this day to avoid lugging bags all days while there.

 - About subway and bus fares. Get free rides when you tap to pay. Only pay for the rides you take up to a cap of \$34 in a 7-day period, as long as you use the same card or device.

SIGHTSEEING BY DAY



What: Statue of Liberty and Ellis Island Tours

When: June 28th

Where: Battery Park, NY - New York City (Manhattan) Departure



By Subway - Local 1 (7th Avenue Line) to South Ferry, or Express (Lexington Avenue Line) 4 or 5 to Bowling Green, or Local from Brooklyn/Queens R/W to Whitehall Street Station.



By Bus - M15 (East Side) South Ferry, or M6 (West Side) from 57th street.



By Car - East Side - take FDR Drive South, Exit 1 South Ferry Battery Park. West Side - take Westside Highway South (9A) to Battery Park.

Time: proposed time 10 am? If we choose the 10 am slot, that means we would need to give ourselves enough time for our morning routine. Such as grabbing coffee/breakfast and arrive at the ferry around 9 am. This gives us time to wait for the ferry should it not be there at 9 and then be transported to the Statue of Liberty which takes about 15-20 mins). This gives us time to not be rushed.

Note: When choosing your reservation date and time, this is your entry into the Security Facility and not a specific ferry departure The ferry ride to the Statue of Liberty from Battery Park or Liberty State Park takes about 15–20 minutes. The ferry departs every 20–35 minutes. Statue of Liberty tours are self-guided, and can last between three to five hours, depending on your pace when you visit both Ellis and Liberty Island.

Price: \$32

What's included: Tickets include access to both Liberty Island and Ellis Island by ferry boat. Tickets can be purchased in advance through our web site or in person at the ticket box offices near the ferry departure points in New York City and in New Jersey. Advanced purchases are highly recommended to avoid lines at the ticket offices and the chance that your preferred time will sell out. Your E-Ticket with a timed reservation ensures Priority Check-in and Boarding on the date of your tour.

Security Screening - Visitors to the Statue of Liberty and Ellis Island must pass through security screening before boarding any ferry.

Audio Tours - Audio Tours are now included with the purchase of every ticket. The audio tours, which complement the National Park Service (NPS) Ranger-led tours on the islands, provide a major enhancement to the visitor experience on both islands.

Note: Large bags are not allowed on Liberty or Ellis Islands. Backpacks, strollers and large umbrellas are not permitted in the Monument.




